Jesus knows everything about the church (Psalm 139:1-4).

This gives both reverence toward Jesus and comfort and encouragement.

- 1) He commended the deeds and hard work of the church in Ephesus.
- 2) He commended their perseverance.
- 3) He commended them for having discernment and not falling into the deception of evil people and false teachings.

Heresies at that time: Gnosticism, Docetism, and the Nicolaitans (1 John 4:2-3; 2 John 1:10-11)

They were able to overcome because they had been well taught through Paul (Acts 20:29-30, 31-32).

- 4) The church in Ephesus hated what Jesus hates (v. 6).

**3. Rebuke of the Church in Ephesus**

1. The church in Ephesus had abandoned its first love (v. 4).

As they devoted all their energy to fighting heresy and distinguishing truth from falsehood and good from evil, the church became centered on work rather than love.  
- "People over work, and God over people."

Those who love the Lord love their neighbors, the Word, and the church.

2. Repent and restore your first love (v. 5).

If they do not restore their first love, the Lord will remove their lampstand.

This means that the church can no longer continue to exist.

A church without love for the Lord and love for brothers and sisters cannot endure.

Let us become a church that is praised by the Lord, a church that restores its first love for Him.
